

Monthly Report: July 2025

This report summarizes the club's service projects in collaboration with its partners during the month of July 2025.

1. "Pen for Change" RC Rajdhani Kickoff

- **Date:** July 1, 2025
- **Partners:** Rotaract Club of Rajdhani
- **Description:** This project, the first of the new Rotary Year, was successfully conducted at Shree Setidevi Secondary School. It involved the distribution of essential stationery materials to **367 students**, providing them with the tools and encouragement needed for their education.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 26,850

2. Community Vision Restored: Successful Eye Screening Camp

- **Date:** July 4, 2025
- **Partners:** Rotaract Club of Rajdhani, Sathya Sai Kendra, Thapathali, and B.P. Koirala Lions Center For Ophthalmic Studies (BPKLCOS)
- **Description:** An eye screening camp was organized at Sathya Sai Kendra, providing vital eye care services to nearly 200 individuals, including residents from the Sukumbasi area of Sankhamul. This project directly supports the District Governor's "Give Eyesight Back" campaign.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 12,000

3. RC Rajdhani Delivered Hope and Mobility

- **Date:** July 6, 2025
- **Partners:** Nepal Police Hospital
- **Description:** As part of the Disability Support Initiative, two wheelchairs were handed over to the Nepal Police Hospital during the club's 24th Joint Installation Ceremony. This initiative contributes to the district-wide goal of distributing 1,000 wheelchairs.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 15,600

4. Rotary Tree Plantation

- **Date:** July 26, 2025
- **Partners:** RC Boudha, RC Gongabu, RC Greenland Kathmandu, RC Kathmandu Circle, RC Kathmandu Downtown, RC Matribhumi Baluwater, RC Thamel, Rotaract Club of Rajdhani, RCC Dakchinkali, Nepal Police Special Task Force, Kapan, and Budhanilkantha Municipality Ward No. 11, Kapan.
- **Description:** In alignment with the District Governor's goal of planting 50,000 trees, the club organized a significant tree plantation. The combined efforts of multiple clubs and local authorities resulted in the successful planting of approximately 500 fruit trees.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 17,500 (Cost of RC Rajdhani only)

5. Tree Plantation in Dakchinkali

- **Date:** July 26, 2025

- **Partners:** Rotaract Club of Rajdhani, RCC Dakchinkali and Dakshinkali Municipality Ward no. 3
- **Description:** Around **200 fruit trees** were planted at Shree Setidevi Secondary School and the Pharping Hydropower Water Reservoir in Sokhel, Dakshinkali. The project's goal was to plant trees that provide both long-term nutritional and economic benefits, while also supporting the District Governor's initiative to plant 50,000 trees in a single day. To ensure the new trees would thrive, we also **fenced the entire planting area** for protection.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 70,500

6. Support Seniors' Mobility and Quality of Life

- **Date:** July 26, 2025
- **Partners:** RCC Dakchinkali
- **Description:** **15 walking sticks** were distributed to the needy elderly people located in Dakshinkali Municipality area. The aim of this project was to support seniors' mobility and enhance their quality of life. The support was done after the need assessment by RCC Dakchinkali. The total cost of the walking sticks was supported by **President Nominee Rtn. Dinesh Ratna Bajracharya**.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 10,650

7. Baby Products and Healthy Food Distribution at Central Jail

- **Date:** July 31, 2025
- **Partners:** Central Jail's Women's Cell
- **Description:** In observance of Maternal and Child Health Month, the club distributed essential baby products and healthy food items to 10 children under five and 150 women at the Central Jail. Items included baby essentials, eggs, and a variety of fresh fruits.
- **Total Cost:** Rs. 31,488

In July, we did 7 service projects, and its total cost was Rs. 1,84,588
